Distribution of doctoral dissertations

Instructions related to the distribution of doctoral dissertations that are being published in the journal [Dissertationes Forestales](#) differ from the Faculty's general instructions.

Distribution of Dissertationes Forestales

School of Forest Sciences covers the costs of printing 40 ordinary doctoral dissertations. The official distribution is to be done as follows by the student:

- 1 for the opponent, custodian and doctoral candidate
- 1 for the Head of School of Forest Sciences
- 1 for the UEF Rector of own campus
- 1 for the Dean of the Faculty of Science and Forestry
- 1 for faculty (head of administration, Kaisa Laitinen), pre-examiners and supervisors
- 4 for the Finnish Society for Forest Sciences

Copies printed at the expense of School of Forest Sciences include the following nine legal copies, which the press (PunaMusta Oy) sends without order of the candidate:

- • 3 for UEF library (1 of them is the copy for public viewing)
- • 6 for national archives (legal deposit copies)

The printed version of complete PhD thesis, including summary and articles, must be available for public 10 days before the dissertation, including weekend days. The e-version of Dissertationes Forestales, however, must be published on the Dissertationes Forestales web pages 10 weekdays (ie. excluding Saturdays & Sundays) before the dissertation.
