


The Student Union is YOUR UNION

- ISYY is an independent organisation, although closely linked with the University
- The main purpose of ISYY is
 - to look after the rights and interests of both Finnish and international students and negotiate better rights and benefits for all students at the University through interest advocacy.
 - ISYY also provides services, arranges a variety of social activities and events on campus and provides students with affordable sports services (SYKETTÄ)








Students making decisions for other students

Representative Council



- The highest decision-making body in ISYY consisting of 39 representatives chosen among UEF students by student elections
- Tasks are, for example, appointing the Executive Board, approving the action plan and budget, deciding the amount of the membership fee
- Term of office lasts for two years





- The Executive Board consists of a Chairperson, a Vice Chairperson and other members who have a specific area of responsibility
- Tasks include, for instance, executing the action plan, representing ISYY on a national level, lobbying students' rights on a local level
- UEF students chosen by the Representative Council every November/December
- Term of office lasts for one year



Student Representatives





- Organise activities for ISYY members
- To get involved in teams' activities you do not have to know a lot about ISYY: in teams you will get straight into action
- All ISYY members can apply to become a team member or a team leader when we are searching for members for our new teams.
- Student representatives in administration, i.e. Hallopeds, are regular students who make sure that student perspective is always taken into account in UEF decision-making, and that students' interests are being looked after
- Degree students who have registered as present at the University are eligible to apply
- After the term of office has ended (2 years), it is possible to claim 1–10 credit point (ECTS) for acting as a student representative

Problems with studies or grading?





= aims to improve the status of students in the society and aims to make sure that students have every opportunity to live a good and meaningful life on both local and national level Includes and involves guidance, counselling, negotiations, discussions, dialogue, networking... Examples:

- Course grading is late
- Unclearness with a contract (student housing company etc.)
- Language barrier or communication issues

You are encouraged to get in touch with ISYY if you ever feel that the student perspective is somehow being disregarded, either at the UEF or in society in general.

The golden rule of the Interest Advocacy Team of ISYY is that 'no matter how well things are going, there is always room for improvement!

SYKETTÄ Sports Services


- Great variety of group exercise classes, ball sports and gyms
- All Sykettä users need to create a user account at Sykettä website first - @student.uef.fi/@uef.fi email required for registering
- Membership can be purchased at ISYY's office with cash/card and online from the Sykettä webstore

 - 22€/36€ ball sports & gym,
 - 39€/69€ group exercise (includes ball sports & gym)



- International degree students must join (completing a bachelor's or master's degree) just like Finnish students
- Exchange students (and post graduate students) are welcome to join – and most do!





How joining ISYY works in practice?



Membership fee spring 2024

- (75 € academic year 2023-2024)
- 40 € spring semester 2024
- PhD students 31,50 €/spring semester

Payment

- Degree students can pay online in Oili with a credit card when registering as a present student to UEF
- Exchange and PhD students can pay the fee to ISYY's bank account (Isyy.fi: Membership)
- However, if online payment is impossible, students can pay with cash/card at ISYY office (NB: The largest banknote we accept is 50 €)

Remember to register your membership



If you are a degree student and pay your ISYY membership fee in Oili, your ISYY membership is automatically registered and no further actions are required regarding the Student Union membership.

Register your membership

<u>Register your ISYY membership</u> at the Student & Learning Services:

- Those who pay via bank transfer can attach the receipt to the UEF registration form (all students)
- If the student has already registered to UEF, they can send their receipt via email to opiskelu@uef.fi (exchange student)
- Those who pay at the ISYY office can take the receipt to Student & Learning Services' customer service desk in person (all students)


Student card (Frank)

Why?

- Official student ID -> the easiest way to get student discounts and benefits everywhere around the country throughout the year
- No need to get a new certificate every 3 months or so
- Proof of ISYY's membership




Where to order?

- Digital student card (0 €) can be used by downloading Frank App from App Store or Google Play Store
 - The digital student card works after ISYY's member records have been transferred to Frank. This might take a few days
- Plastic student cards (25 €) are ordered online frank.fi/en
 - Plastic student cards will be delivered to your home address, delivery time c. 2-4 weeks
 - Once you have received your plastic card, collect the term sticker from ISYY's office. The card is not valid without the sticker! Please bring a photo ID with you (e.g. passport)

If you have any problems with your student card order or your digital student card doesn't work, please contact Frank's customer service by email: info@frank.fi



Check before ordering that you have:

- Enrolled as an attending student to UEF
- Paid your ISYY membership and registered it
- Your study right number
- You have a profile picture of your face that is:
 - Square shaped (1:1 ratio) jpg (no png or pdf), size at least 300 x 300 px
 - Similar to a passport photo but with colors, a good quality selfie is fine
- A payment instrument for the plastic student card to pay for the order. You can pay for the student card order using a debit/credit card e.g. Visa, VisaElectron or MasterCard


Student Associations
